## RISK STATEMENT

Watercraft Racing is by its nature a dangerous sport and therefore inherently involves an element of risk.

By participating in or becoming involved with watercraft racing organised by Powerboat P1 either as a participant, team member or otherwise individuals agree and acknowledge that:

- (i) they are aware of the inherent risk involved in the sport and accept responsibility for exposing themselves to such inherent risk, including risks to their person, their property, drowning, hypothermia, collision injuries burns and other physical injuries as well as possible death
- (ii) they have satisfied themselves that they have the necessary skill and knowledge to take part in the event and deal with the conditions that may arise in the course of a race
- (iii) they will not participate in the event whilst under the undue influence of alcohol, drugs or whilst otherwise unfit to participate
- (iv) they are responsible for the safety of themselves their team their personal watercraft and their property whether afloat or ashore
- (v) the management of their personal water including insurance is solely their responsibility
- (vi) technical scrutineering does not constitute a condition survey of the personal watercraft and it is solely their responsibility to decide whether or not to start or to continue in any Jetcross race
- (vii) ensuring the efficiency and suitability of the helmets and wetsuit vests worn is solely their responsibility
- (viii) the provision of a race management team, patrol boats and other volunteers by the event organisers does not relieve them of their responsibilities
- (ix) the provision of patrol boat cover is limited to such assistance particularly in extreme weather conditions as can be practically provided in the circumstances
- (x) to be bound by the conditions of the Race Entry Form, Racing Instructions and the General Competition Rules of Jetcross and the IJSBA
- (xi) they will accept the decisions of the organising committee and officials nominated by the organising committee.

## INDEMNITY

Participants in the event will be required on signing on to the event to save harmless and keep indemnified:

- (a) The owners of the premises at which the event is held;
- (b) The organising club, the sponsors and the IJSBA and their respective officials, servants and agents; and,
- (c) The other personal watercraft owners, drivers, passengers or mechanics engaged in the meeting (together with the "Indemnified Parties") AGAINST all actions, claims, costs, expenses and demands in respect of loss of or damage to the property of or personal injury sustained to the Indemnified Parties to the extent caused by the participants, their crew, their boat, their mechanics, support team, representatives or agents.

## IMPORTANT NOTE

Persons under the age of 18 must have written authority signed by either Parent or Guardian, Proof of age is required.

THE RESPONSIBILITY FOR A RIDER'S DECISION TO PARTICIPATE IN A RACE  
OR TO CONTINUE RACING IS THEIRS ALONE

## 1. EVENT SANCTION

This event has been approved by the International Jetsport Boating Association (IJSBA). The IJSBA will serve as the sanctioning body for the event and his international promoter Powerboat P1 provides the event insurance package. All competitors must be current IJSBA members.

## 2. P1 MEMBERSHIP

Riders taking part in a P1 event must hold a P1 membership card. The cost of membership is automatically included in the fee when registering for a rider's first event of the season and is valid until the first event of 2020.

## 7. RULES

The race/s will be run under current rules as stated in Jetcross 2019 rulebook together with these Race Instructions and any other instructions issued before or at Riders' Briefings or in Race Bulletins. The Organisers reserve the right to change these Instructions at any time for safety reasons, provided that any change will be in accordance with the current rules. Any changes will be notified to competitors in a Race Bulletin and, if possible, announced at Riders' Briefing. Any infringement of the Rules or of the Race Instructions, or instructions issued at Riders' Briefings or in race Bulletins may lead to disqualification or other penalties being applied by the organising club.

Organisers have the right to refuse any watercraft which they consider unsuitable and/or which does not conform to the requirements of the present rules. The Organisers may cancel or postpone the event or a race at any time in the event of bad weather, equipment failure or otherwise. The entry fee is not refundable

Insurance can be purchased on site for €80 for the week-end or €120 yearly if the competitor has still an **IJSBA valid membership deliver by his country of residency**.

Dry Pit is located on Braudel Car Park - 43 Avenue Jean-Baptiste Mattei 83500 La Seyne-sur-Mer. Dry pit has a limited place, it is strictly and exclusively reserved for riders' vehicles. Accompanying persons will have to use car parks next to the official dry pit. A member of the organization will be responsible for your placement. In no case should you deploy your structure on the paddock without the agreement of the pit manager.

Electricity supplied with electrical boxes dispatched on the dry pit (motorhome electric plug PK17 type) available Friday morning. A fresh water point will be available on the dry pit. Toilets and showers are on the beach. Barbecues are strictly forbidden inside the dry pit. According to the P1 Jetcross regulation section JX44 (a) 9. **Noise limitation inside the pilot paddock will be applied from 23h on the night from Friday to Saturday night and Saturday to Sunday night.**

**No reservation in the dry pit is permitted by riders for other riders. First come, first served.**

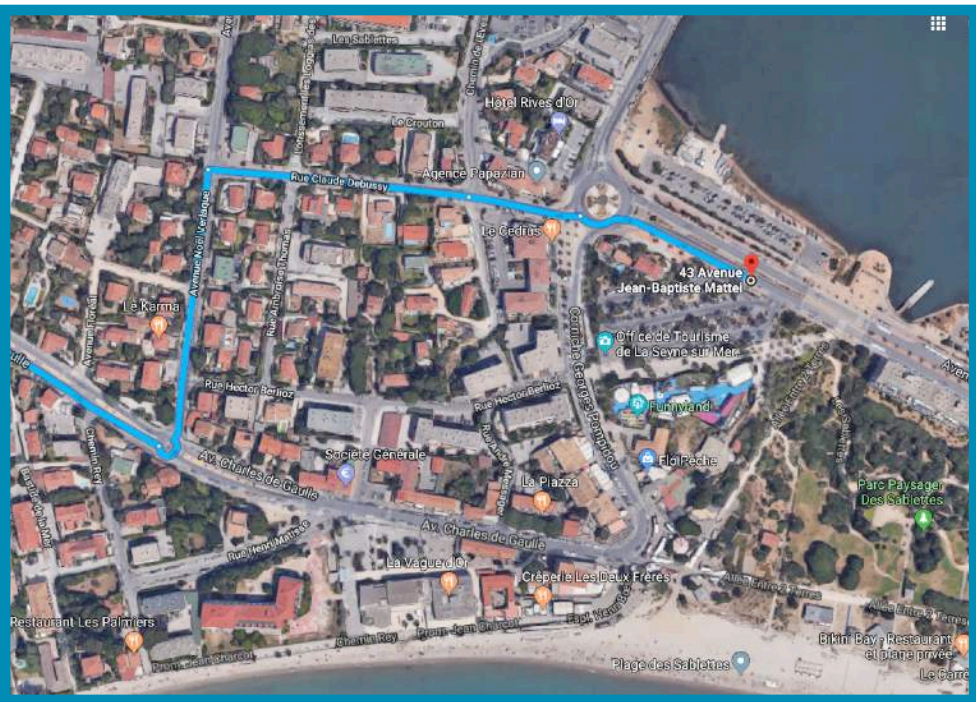

## 10. TECHNICAL INSPECTION

Pre-race tech will take place in accordance with Class specific rules in 2019 Jetcross Rulebook. Pre tech will take place in the Dry Pit areas starts Friday from 2pm until 10.30pm. Post race tech place will be announce during riders briefing.

## 11. LAUNCHING

The launch will be open from Saturday 10.30am and until the end of the competition, is the responsibility of each rider/team. It must not intervene before the pre-race technical inspection, unless otherwise specified. Pilots are reminded to comply with local regulations. All information will be given during the pilot briefing. It is forbidden to launch on its own without the race director's authorisation from the official start of the event and at the venue of the event. **WARNING: the bay of Toulon is formally forbidden for any PWC - you can not under any circumstances put your machine in the bay of Lazaret (in front of the dry pit)**

## 12. OFFICIAL PRACTICE ARRANGEMENTS

Official Jetcross practice and qualifying session taking part on SATURDAY between 10.30 am - 12.30 am Competitors must register and pass technical inspection before being allowed to take part in practice. No Access to the race course on Friday.

## 13. RIDERS BRIEFING

All Jetcross Riders' (Pro - Pro/Am - Am) briefing will take place at **Grand Hotel des Sablettes Plage - Hilton Saturday 9.00am** , 500m far from the dry pit. All Riders must attend the appropriate briefing. A Roll Call may be held. Penalty for absence may be disqualification from starting the race or other penalties as defined in Class Rules or by the race organisers. Breathalyser and Drug tests may be given.



## 14. BEACH STARTS AND SPECIFIC QUALIFICATION PROCESS

Full details of the starting procedure will be given at Riders' Briefing however all class specific starts and qualification process are explained in the 2019 JX rulebook.

**Start Jetcross:** Beach start with electronic elastic rubber or flag (if important shore break)

**Lap/Finish Line JX** It is likely to be marked by chequered buoy between

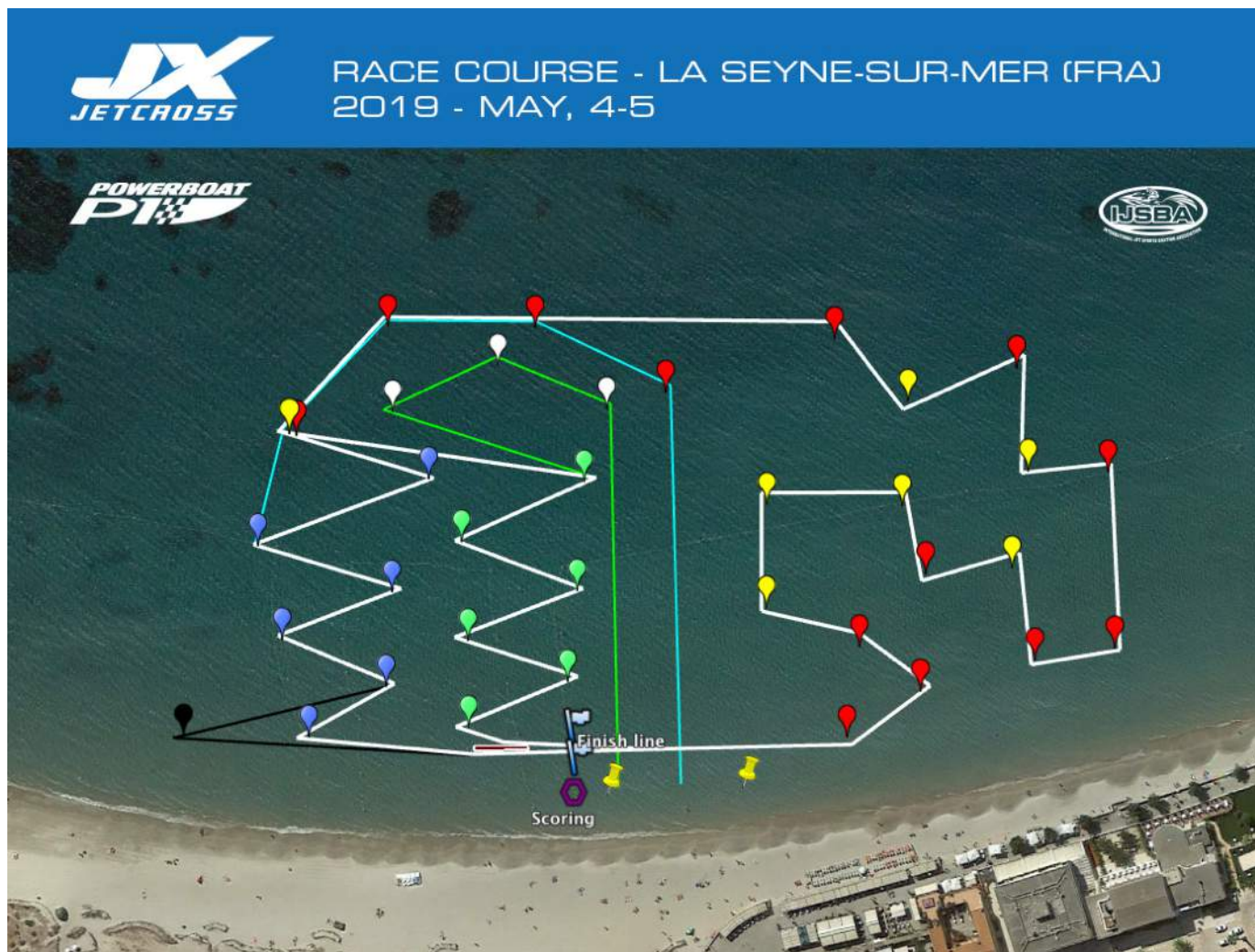


## JETCROSS COURSE DETAILS

The final course design dependant on weather conditions and entry - subject to change.

Distance : 1260m // Double holeshot and slalom parallel // 12 red buoys - 6 yellow buoys - 6 green buoys - 6 blue buoys - 4 white buoys - 2 holeshot mark - 1 black buoys - 2 checked buoys // Total of 36 marks

## 15. FLAG SIGNALS

All flag signals are fully described in 2019 Jetcross Rulebook General Racing Rules and Class specific rules where differences occur. All Competitors must have a full understanding of all flag signals.

## 16. POST-RACE TECHNICAL

Post Tech tents area will be announce during riders briefing. Competitors must be available with their craft and all relevant mandatory equipment required by class rules for post-race Tech if required, up to one hour after the posting of the results. One or more engines may be checked and fuel sampling may take place.

## 17. PENALTIES

Penalties will be applied as per class rules – see rule JX45.

## 18. PROTESTS

Protests should be submitted in accordance with 2019 Jetcross Rulebook – JX46.

A Mandatory arbitration session with the Race Director or Appointed person is to be held before any formal protests or appeals will be accepted. If unresolved the rider will be given a P1 Jetcross protest or appeal form. Formal protests or appeals must be made in writing by the rider/s involved (use model on 2019 Jetcross Rulebook - JX46) and will be logged with the Series Administrator. Protests from third parties will not be accepted.

## 19. PRIZE GIVING

The winners (first past the checkers) in Pro Ski must be available for TV proposes.

Podium presentations will take place at the P1 Race Podium in accordance with the timetable.

Trophies will be presented to the top 3 in each class.

### IMPORTANT – PODIUM FINISHERS MUST BE PRESENT AND WEAR WETSUIT AND LIFEJACKET

All podium finishers must wear their wetsuit and lifejacket on the podium. Failure to do so will result in penalties as per rule JX45.

Riders are asked to refrain from inviting family members to join them on the podium until after the official presentation, photography and filming has taken place. Riders may then ask for further time for family photos.

### SAFETY INFORMATION

**Safety takes priority over racing at all times**

**All race boats MUST observe the International Rules for the Prevention of Collisions at Sea (IRPCS) when encountering any other non-racing craft.**

- a. Swimmers, board sailors, private and commercial craft of all types may be encountered. Competitors are reminded to keep a sharp look-out at all times and to take the necessary action in accordance with the IRPCS rules.
- b. Competitors are reminded to keep a sharp look-out at all times for any marine wildlife that may be encountered in the vicinity of the race course and take the necessary avoiding action.
- c. Competitors are warned to remember their speed and the fact that other craft may not be fully aware or able to keep clear.
- d. Competitors are asked to bear in mind that official patrol and rescue boats have no power to insist that any craft or swimmer should keep clear of the course of the race. Advice can only be given for the safety of other craft and swimmers.
- e. International Code Flag 'A' denotes DIVERS. Competitors must give a wide clearance of at least 100 yards.
- f. The course will be patrolled by official patrol and rescue boats with official observer boats in the vicinity of certain race marks; other race marks may be observed from the shore.
- g. Any official patrol or rescue boat may wave a yellow flag to give warning of imminent danger in its vicinity.
- h. Competitors seeing this signal are to acknowledge the signal, proceed with caution, not overtake other race boats whilst in the area of the incident and keep clear of the danger area. Any competitor who ignores or abuses the yellow flag may be penalised
